- Call to Order Planning Commission Chair, Steve Lueck, called the regular meeting of the Altura Planning Commission, held at the Altura City Hall, to order at 6:00 p.m. with members Don Dvorak, Matt Monahan, Raelene Stanislawski and Becky Zittel present. Geralyn LaRoque was in attendance.

- Building Permits There was no new building permits to review.
- Council Report The Council asked the commission to review the Accessory Building zoning. The 12 feet setback from the primary residents is not the State Building Code. The Commission recommends leaving as is.

- Gerilyn LaRoque Gerilyn LaRoque talked about Eric Hilke grinding feed from 8:30 p.m. to 2 a.m. with loud tractors, bobcat, and lights that are distracting. He does not do this during the day and wondering why at night. The City does have a nuisance ordinance. The Clerk will check to see how to measure the decibels. She is also concerned about him spreading the manure on the field by 2nd Street NE as she said it was excessive. Eric had the proper permitting for his feedlot from Winona County.
